The characters and story are based on the people in my life!


Q: Do you want to give any message to your readers?

I quit my job leaving behind all my experience in the sector to do something completely different. In 2014, I set up my own children's entertainment business which was a huge success.





Author Interview

Dr. Christie Black-Murrell

Q: First tell us something about yourself?

I am a big kid at heart who loves to share stories aloud and bring characters to life! I get the opportunity to do this often in my daily work as a Elementary School Counselor. It really is exciting when I get to share the stories that I have written myself. I am an author, counselor, and speaker who loves to speak life into people and show kids especially that there is still "good" in the world. I am a devoted wife and mom of two adventurous little girls (6 and 4).

Q: How and when your journey started as a writer?

My journey as a writer began from the time I could hold my pen steady. I could always be found with a journal in my hands especially starting around the age of 10. I used to make up stories of far away places or places that I read about in books. Then as a teen I began writing poetry or what I thought was just the many thoughts that consumed my head. This was like therapy for me and so my journal became my safe place where I would write every feeling and thought down.

Q: When did you write your first story? Is it published or not?

My first story was probably written as a kid but it was never published just shared with my class. However, my poetry that got me

through some rough times became my first story. I went and looked through every old journal that I had and created a compilation book of poetry about different feelings. This book was called, Random Thoughts of a Perplexed, Relaxed Soul and was released in 2009. However, the publishing process was very difficult for me and I have been unable to get any more copies of this book and for that reason I re-released it this year for my birthday.

Q: Tell us something more about your books?

All of my books deal with social emotional learning. They focus on self awareness and social awareness mostly. I believe in using my writing as an avenue to sprinkle some positivity back into the world. It is always my hope that when a person or kid finishes one of my books that will feel empowered and encouraged. This is with my poetry books, my journals, and of course my Children's books.

Q: Why do you choose kids as your reader? is there any specific reason?

As a counselor I have seen the importance of speaking positivity into the lives of children. I have seen their struggles with self esteem, self love, self resiliency and wanted to meet that need. Plus, becoming a mom and believing in the importance of reading but not just any books I wanted books that featured children that looked like my babies. I wanted them to

see themselves on covers and know that they can be and do great things. Lastly, I simply love seeing the smile on a kid's face when they hear a great story and I wanted to be the one to write it.

Q: How did these stories and characters come to your mind?

I am forever in my head and have always been a daydreamer. However, having two little girls I often picture them in my stories mixed with the many bubbling personalities that I counsel in my daily job at the Elementary school.

Q: Do you want to give any message for your readers?

I want my readers to know that I write to show them that there is still good in our world and that they can be that "good" even when they don't see it. I also want my readers to know that it is in a book that the limits to where they can go and what they can do no longer exists...So, Keep reading Keep dreaming, You will do great things!
