Heeeyy Dandelion is a colorfully illustrated children's book that gently addresses childhood self-esteem, honesty, and family-belonging.

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In the story, young Ana struggles with who is and her place in her family after being adopted. Her adoptive mother shares with her the attributes and life cycle of a dandelion. Though beautiful as a flower, it is often considered a weed because it blooms in unwanted or unexpected places. Though often unappreciated, Ana's mother details just how unique and valuable the dandelion truly is to the environment; and further explains that the dandelion doesn't need perfect conditions to grow...but rather, just a crack of possibility for its roots to be established. From there, the dandelion has everything it needs to be successful. Similarly, that is what Ana's family desires for her.

Q: First tell us something about yourself?

I am a very happy mum of 3 amazing children and have been teaching in primary schools for over 20 years. I enjoy spending time with my family, baking and I love to read, I will read absolutely anything and everything! Most of all, I love to laugh and be silly and just try to have fun!

Q: How and when did your journey start as a writer?

My journey as a writer began after the birth of my second child. He was a very anxious toddler and lacked confidence in so many aspects of childhood. My third child came along and she also doubted herself and her abilities. Their lack of belief in themselves was soul destroying as they constantly felt that they were not 'good enough' or 'I can't do that like such a person can.' Despite reassuring them that they were great as they were (and they were and still are!) the only way that I could really get this message home to them was through telling stories and so "The Amazing Hidden Talents of Anibabs' was created!

Q: When did you write your first story? Is it published or not?

The first book of the series 'Bubbles' was told to my children a quite a few years ago but only this year did I write the story and publish it.

Q: Tell us something more about your books?

The stories in the series are about a little girl called Anibabs. This name is my daughter's first two names put together! In each story she discovers that she has an amazing hidden talent. In this first book her talent is that of blowing bubbles. Not just normal bubbles but ones from her ears and nose in all sorts of sizes, shapes and of fruits, animals and vehicles too! It is a funny, imaginative story that has many messages. The idea is to help children understand that we are all different, we are all unique and we are all amazing. No-one can do what Anibabs can do and that's ok! We all have our own strengths, and we can all adopt an "I can" attitude if we try.

Q: Why do you choose kids as your reader ? is there any specific reason?

As a teacher and then a parent, I knew that a child's imagination is guite magical and key to their development. These stories capture the imagination of children and are fun but with a deeper meaning to try and help children to understand that they too are amazing! If these stories can help just one child to feel better about themselves, like it did with my own, then all the hard work is worth it!

'Bubbles' was just one of the talents that came to mind after actually blowing bubbles with my children. The talents had to be something unique. This way, my children could understand that it's ok not to be able to do something that someone else can do! So, while we couldn't blow bubbles of dogs and cows or of squares and trains, like Anibabs, we COULD blow bubbles and this led on to talk about all the other amazing things they could do!

The messages that come from these stories can be guite powerful for our little ones. There is so much competition and feelings of needing to be the best that it is easy to forget to praise the little things they do and remind them of how great they are. If you enjoyed 'Bubbles' then please keep an eye out for the next story in the series which will be released early 2023!

Heeeyy Dandelion!

Q: First tell us something about yourself?

My name is Dawn Charleston-Green, Founder and CEO of Dawn of a New Day 365, LLC. DND365 is a movement for women journeying through everyday life - the good, bad, ugly, and unexpected; overcoming with TRUTH and TRANSPARENCY in a way that leads to TRANSFORMATION.

Through my blog articles, videos, and panel discussions, I provide content and conversations around the concerns that matter most to women, our families, and communities.

My goal is to give voice to those things that women and families have been forced to deal with in secrecy, shame, and silence. By sharing my own stories, as well as the testimonies of others, I seek to normalize life experiences like marriage, parenting, grief, infertility, and career struggles by helping women understand that they are not alone. The hope of DND365 is to provide a safe space for women to hear and have needed conversations.

I am also the author of the 5-Day Morning COFFEE Devotional and the children's book, Heeeyy Dandelion.

Apart from being an entrepreneur and a writer/author, I'm also a wife, mother, consultant, and speaker.

Q: How and when did your journey start as a writer?

I've been writing since I was a child. Having been an only child for 15 years (prior to the arrival of my younger brother), I found fulfillment in creativity and imagination, and in absorbing everything around me. Aside from just being in the moment, writing was a big part of me processing my world, my unique experiences, and my interpretation of those experiences.

Additionally, I contribute a large part of my journey to writing to my late grandmother who nurtured the writer in me. She was constantly encouraging my cousins and I to not wait for moments to happen, but to create them instead. So the three of us, (I, now in my late 40s, and them in their mid-50s) have been creating our entire lives.

Though born in Natchez Mississippi in 1915 (a very desolate time), surprisingly, my grandmother was always one with words and poetry. She helped all of us to see our spaces so colorfully, and to not allow what we didn't see to keep us from dreaming of what could be.

With all that said, I often wrote down what I saw. I planned the details for what could be. And most of my life, I've just been fulfilling the vision; writing the rest of the story as I go along.

Q: When did you write your first story? Is it published or not?

I probably wrote my first story in the latter part of elementary school. I definitely wrote some stories in high school. None of them are published, but I can remember some details of a few. Back then, I mostly wrote or thought of fictional stories...fantasy. Today, I prefer reality and stories that show experiences, growth, maturity, and evolution.

Q: Tell us something more about your books?

Currently, I've published two books, along with companions to them. The first, the 5-Day Morning C.O.F.F.E.E. Devotion was published in 2021. This devotion was written to help Christian women develop or deepen their faith journey; providing both a method and message for committing time in devotion with intentionality. To assist with the process, I also created a prayer journal for reflections and goals.

My second published work is one that I've been reeling off of since the spring of this year, entitled HEEEYY DANDELION!

HEEEYY DANDELION is a story of an 8-year-old girl, Ana, who struggles with self-esteem and honesty; primarily due to her struggle with understanding being adopted. Ana's adoptive mother explains the life cycle and attributes of a dandelion; explaining to Ana that though beautiful as a flower, the dandelion is often considered a weed because many don't understand its value. However, her mother further explains that though the dandelion may appear in unwanted or unexpected places, it doesn't need perfect conditions to grow; but rather, just a crack of possibility.

Through her depiction of the dandelion, Ana's mother helps her to understand that she is exactly where she needs to be and has everything within her to grow into something beautiful.

Q: Why do you choose kids as your reader ? is there any specific reason?

I'm split. I write to women, children, and families. In actuality, however, Heeeyy Dandelion accidentally morphed into a children's book. It was originally a blog that I wrote to my women's platform, entitled Bloom Wherever You Grow, Dandelion.

In the article I shared and compared the attributes of the dandelions to similarities of women with impeccable inner strength and resilience; despite at times feeling unseen or unappreciated.

Coincidentally, soon after I released the article, I found myself in a difficult conversation with my adopted daughter; a conversation in which she was questioning how and whether she fit into our family. In that moment, and several encounters before, she felt as though she couldn't meet expectations in school and behavior. I realized then that she too needed to understand the attributes of the dandelion; sharing with her that regardless of how she might have become a part of our family, she was okay to just be herself. Helping her to see that her uniqueness added value to our family, and that she can be confident that we had no intentions of plucking her up (as the dandelion often is). As a family, we want her to grow strong roots with us so that she can be successful and go far, just like the seeds of a dandelion does.





Q: How did these stories and characters come to your mind?

I believe that it is through transparency that we reach people the most. For that reason, I knew that I wanted the characters of Heeeyy Dandelion to be true reflections of my daughter and I. However, this project was the first time I worked with an illustrator. The first go-round I was scammed. Literally. Someone on Instagram pitched to me and offered to create a sketch. After I paid them a deposit, the profile was completely deleted. Fortunately the deposit amount wasn't much.

After that experience there were a few others who weren't able to deliver on time or in expectation. Finally though, Christian Rodriguez with Your Children's Book.com was able to capture the very essence of what I had in my head. I was amazed at how he gave my thoughts faces -- me and my daughter's faces. His first sketch blew me away and brought me to tears. I knew then he was the one to bring the story to life. Actually, his care and support, and attention to detail, lit a fire in me that I believe propelled the project forward and FURTHER than I had ever expected or intended.

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Floppy Bunny's New Friends Joonne Eloine



Q: First tell us something about yourself?

I am a biological, adoptive, and step-mother, as well as a biological, and adoptive grandmother. I am employed as a Special Needs Teacher at a local inner-city high school, and have been working in the field for 30+ years. I enjoy being out in nature, especially walking in the woods, sitting by lakes or streams, kayaking and camping. Sitting by a fire with my family is a favorite past-time that we all enjoy. Children and animals have always been special to me, and have been the motivation for both my career and my books.

Q: How and when did your journey start as a writer?

I began writing poems as a child, which continued into my adult years. I have journaled off and on as a method of self-care when needed, but never took writing seriously until recently.

Q: When did you write your first story? Is it published or not?

I was motivated to write the original story, "A New Home for Floppy Bunny," after witnessing the trauma that the foster care system has on many children while going through the adoption process myself 20 years ago. I didn't pursue publishing my story, however, until my adoptive daughter was herself in the process of adopting a child approximately two years ago. I have since published four books, all in the "Floppy Bunny" series, this year.

Q: Tell us something more about your books?

In the first book, a young bunny finds himself in need of a new home. During his journey, he meets three other families (robins, ducks and turtles), who gently and lovingly explain to him why they would not be a good match for him. Although saddened, Floppy Bunny stays hopeful, and eventually meets a family of bunnies who happily adopt him, even though he is a little different from them.

The following three books, "Floppy Bunny's New Friends," are whimsical tales about Floppy Bunny introducing his new family to the Duck, Robin, and Turtle families. During each of his visits, he begins to envy some of his friends' abilities that he does not possess. The two mothers in the story get together and create situations that allow Floppy Bunny to experience each ability in some way. In the end of each book, Floppy Bunny realizes that although it was fun to try something new, he is happy being who he is.

Q: Why do you choose kids as your reader ? is there any specific reason?

There are two reasons for choosing kids as my reader. First, these stories were written for young children in the foster care system because of my own experience adopting children from this system and seeing the damage that their experiences can have on their psyches. Second, I love children, and doing whatever I can do nurture and protect them in any way is a priority for me.

Q: How did these stories and characters come to your mind?

The story was a result of my adopted children's experiences in the foster care system prior to joining our family. I wanted to create a story that young children could relate to without directly referencing foster care or adoption. My love of animals and nature made the creation of the characters and settings in my books a natural choice.

Q: Do you want to leave any message for your readers?

The intended message to young children who hear this story is that their situation is never due to any fault of their own, and that while waiting for their "forever family," they may meet families who cannot adopt them. There are many reasons for this (most of which a young child will not understand), but it is not because they are "unlovable" or "unwanted," which, unfortunately, is often part of the trauma many children experience while in the system.

Although the first book was originally written with foster care and adopted children in mind, its message is an important one for every child to hear. As there are currently hundreds of thousands of children in the foster care system in the U.S., the chances are great that most children will meet another child either living in foster care, or who has been adopted at some point. Educating young children about the needs of their peers at this primary level increases empathy, and thereby lessens the stigma and bullying associated with being in foster care or being adopted.

The messages in the last three books are also powerful ones for every child to hear. Learning to love oneself for who you are is a lesson that will serve every child well throughout their life, helping them to navigate social pressures to conform instead of being true to themselves.

I am a mom of 3 amazing adults, Evan, Scott, and Kendra. They are why I chose to become a licensed daycare provider and preschool teacher 32 years ago. This career allowed me to stay home, raise them, supplement my income, and do something I love to do-teach. Over the years, I have been able to help so many families follow their career paths while knowing they are leaving their children in a loving, safe environment when they go off to work. I enjoy traveling with my family when I am not writing books or running my business. There is always some adventure waiting to be explored.

Q: How many books are there in The Power of ...series and which is your favorite?

The series The Power of... consists of four books centered around essential character traits needed in today's world. Each book encourages children to explore how they can make a positive difference in the world. My first three books teach children how to find and share positivity, kindness, and gratitude. My fourth book starts by equipping children to recognize and understand their emotions. This empowers them to be able to empathize with themselves and those around them.

Honestly, I don't have a favorite book because of the unique impactful characteristics of each one. What I can tell you is what I enjoy most about each book.

My most recent book, The Power of Empathy: Be the Friend You've Always Wanted, is such an important message. Children being able to recognize and understand their own emotions allows them to have compassion for themselves and then extend that compassion in the form of empathy to the people around them. In our stressed-out world, empathy is a skill we all need.

Q: How do you celebrate when you finish your book?

As a preschool teacher, my students are my inspiration. I spend a lot of time listening to them, trying to understand their point of view and what they see in their lives. They are a huge part of my journey, so I like to show them My acknowledgment and appreciation. Once I have pushed the publish button or received the first box of books, the children and I usually read the book together and then have a special treat like ice cream or cookies.

Q: Tell us more about your new book, The Power of Empathy?

The Power of Empathy: Be the Friend You've Always Wanted is about recognizing both positive and negative emotions and understanding that it is OK and normal to experience all of them.
