
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

Q: First tell us something about yourself?

My name is Eldonie Mason and I immigrated to the United States from Antigua in 1998. I later graduated magna cum laude from New Jersey City University in 2002 and cum laude from the University of Miami School of Law in 2005. In 2007, I founded Mason Firm LLC, an entertainment, business and fashion law firm based in Newark, NJ and founded Predestined Media LLC in 2020 to create and distribute diverse content. The Adventures of Princess Anyah of Antibarba book series about a Caribbean Princess is the first project from my media company.

Q: How and when did your journey start as a writer?

I have always been interested in writing since high school but never thought to pursue it as a career. In college, I took a creative writing course because I was told it would make me a better legal writer. A few years ago, I took a romance writing course and wrote the first ten chapters of my novel – it is a work in progress.

Q: When did you write your first story? Is it published or not?

Five years ago, my five-year-old niece told me that she could not be a princess because all the princesses were white with long hair. My heart broke. Who told her such a thing? This conversation led me to write her a story about a Black princess with short hair who goes on adventures. That story is now a children's book, The Adventures of Princess Anyah of Antibarba, which was released in March 2022 on Amazon in e-book, paperback and hardcover.

Q: Tell us something more about your books.

It tells the tale of Princess Anyah, a fun-loving, six-year-old who lives with her family in a palace on the tropical island of Antibarba located in the Caribbean. In this book, she goes on her first big adventure, a fishing expedition, with her dad, King Ananda. After the release of my original book in 2022 and coloring book version in 2023, I wanted to ensure that little Afro-Latina Caribbean princesses were able to read the story in their native language so I released the Spanish version in January 2024.

Q: Why do you choose kids as your reader? is there any specific reason?

Representation matters and if little girls like my niece can see themselves as princesses, they will not feel less than. Additionally, the children are our future and they should feel valued.


Q: How did these stories and characters come to your mind?

My niece loves to read. When I took her to the library, I noticed that most children's books with Black characters dealt with slavery, civil rights or race. I was hard pressed to find books where Black children were just having fun. I wanted to change the narrative and when my niece told me she could not be a princess, I had a light bulb moment and found my story arc and characters.


Q: Do you want to leave any message for your readers?







As Carl and his friends settle down to work, Mr B settles down for a well-earned rest. But soon, frustration in the class begins to bubble over, until Carl has a brainwave.....

Q: First tell us something about yourself.

I have been a gardener for six years; before that I was a primary teacher for around fifteen years and I mainly taught maths – my favourite subject. My proudest achievement as a teacher was to lead a change in my last school where children could choose their own level of difficulty in tasks and they sat in mixed groups (no more top, middle and bottom tables!) The children were so positive about this change and it made me think differently about how we learn.

Being a gardener is great – I get to work outside in nature, keep healthy and it also gives me lots of thinking time. So when I'm knee-deep in weeds or I'm pruning a tree, I think of ideas and rhymes, then rush to write them down when I get home. I have two grown up sons who have left home and I live by the sea with my husband, and my slightly naughty dog Basil.

Q: How and when did your journey start as a writer?

Last year I was on a walk with a friend who, like many UK adults, said that she was useless at maths! I told her my favourite maths story (on which '101' is based) and realised I loved the story so much that I went straight home and wrote it down. I write in rhyme because I find it engaging and funny – even reluctant readers love a rhyme! My favourite rhyming authors are Julia Donaldson and Dr Seuss.

Q: When did you write your first story? Is it published or not?

I wrote '101' in September 2023 and it will be published on 5th September 2024 which is neat!

Q: Tell us something more about your books.

My books are stories for 8 – 12 year olds written in rhyme. There aren't many rhyming stories for older children, but I love writing in rhyme and you can have great fun with it. I make myself laugh when I'm writing! '101' is the first in a set of three – the other two are written and Helen, the illustrator, will start work on the second book in January 2025. Helen's illustrations are an important part of the books and they are in a deliberately spiky style to appear to 8-12 year olds. All the books are fictionalised accounts of true stories. '101' is a maths story that will tickle your ribs and blow your mind!

Q: How did these stories and characters come to your mind?

My stories are based on a modern-day London classroom where I taught for many years – the personalities, language and illustrations reflect the children that I taught. All the stories are based on true events and are written to entertain and to provoke creative thinking.

Q: Do you want to leave any message for your readers?

Believe in yourself – if you want to try something new, just do one thing towards it and then build on that bit by bit. In the end, something positive will happen, even if it's not what you first set out to achieve. Start today!




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


























































Anesthesia From Zwith Nurse Nee Nee

This picture book is a valuable tool because it prepares children and parents for what to expect prior to undergoing anesthesia for surgery. Using the alphabet in the story helps kids feel more at ease, and using role-play with their ABCs helps get them prepared before the process The hospital can be a scary setting, but each turn of the page helps parents feel empowered when they learn how they can help in the process of improving the outcome of their child's experience before and after anesthesia is administered.

Q: First tell us something about yourself?


Hi! I'm Katina Currin, aka Nurse Nee Nee, author of the Nurse Nee Nee Series TM. I am a certified registered nurse anesthetist (CRNA). I put little ones to sleep and keep them safe and comfortable during surgery. My experience working with the pediatric population led me to write and share stories that will prepare children and parents for general anesthesia, which is most often required for surgery in the young population.

Q: How and when did your journey start as a writer?

As a child, poetry was my greatest interest. I wish I knew where those poems were now! I recall my mind drifting and writing about things around me, my experiences, mostly at school, and how I was feeling on a particular day. I am currently working on a rhyming book for my young audience!

Q: When did you write your first story? Is it published or not published?

I wrote "Nosey Nancy and the Never-Ending Nosebleed" in 2019 and published it the same year. While proud of all five books, like most authors, I will always have a special love for my first publication! It is an early reader chapter book, and I have often thought of writing a picture storybook version for my younger audience.



My goal with the Nurse Nee Nee Series TM is to align the books with key elements described in health literacy. I focus on writing in plain language where the reader easily understands the information. Also, I aim to write my books considering all reading levels. This is why I have early reader chapter books, picture storybooks, and coloring and activity books. In addition, the stories I write consider our cultural differences, hence, the translation of "Anesthesia From A-Z With Nurse Nee Nee" into Spanish, the second most dominant language in the U.S.


Q: How did these stories and characters come to your mind?

Q: Do you want to leave any messages for your readers?



I still can hardly believe I am really an author! Even after four books and several awards it seems like a dream. Follow your dreams. They can come true! We all must learn to deal with temptations. In Pudgy Possum in a Pickle, Pudgy has trouble coping with a temptation of his own. Pudgy's friend Peppermint tries to warn him, but Pudgy makes a bad decision. Q: Tell us something more about your book.


Similar to the law of attraction, this book focuses on using positive affimations rather than the negative ones in various scenarios. I would say the book is suitable for all ages, not just children.






Mosques In Turkey


