

Q: How did these stories and characters come to your mind?




Q: Do you want to leave any message for your readers?



Q: First tell us something about yourself.


Hi, I'm Karen!



Q: First tell us something about yourself.

I am a mom to a wonderful boy who fills my life with joy, curiosity, and endless energy. We live in Montreal, Quebec, where I balance family life alongside my professional work. Like many parents, motherhood has deeply shaped the way I see the world.

Our days are full of movement, learning, laughter, and play. Children are full of questions and imagination, and every day brings a new little adventure. And when night falls, everything softens: whispers replace noise, hugs bring comfort, and a quiet kind of magic settles in. Those small, tender moments, a hug before sleep, a whispered story, and a quiet laugh are often the ones that stay with us the longest. I realized how quickly this season of life passes, and I wanted to find a way to hold on to those moments, to capture their warmth before they become memories.

Q: How and when did your journey start as a writer?

I began creating books as a way to preserve the precious moments I share with my son. The Magic of Mom's Hugs was inspired by the tenderness of bedtime rituals, where love and reassurance speak without words. Passion Soccer Activity Book reflects the energy and joy of our days, celebrating play, teamwork, and growth.

Q: Tell us something more about your book.

I will speak here in particular about my book The Magic of Mom's Hugs. It is a gentle bedtime story about love, reassurance, and the invisible magic that exists between a parent and a child.

In the story, Lucas believes that his mother's hugs are magical. But one day, his mom feels overwhelmed by worries and begins to wonder if the magic has disappeared. Determined to find it again, she goes on a whimsical journey to ask animal friends for help.

In the end, Lucas reminds her of a beautiful truth: the magic was never lost. It had only been hidden under her worries. The magic of her hugs comes from love, and that love never disappears.

The story is meant to comfort children and parents alike, reminding us that even during difficult moments, the love we share remains a powerful source of strength.

Q: How did you create the magical system in your book and characters?

The magical world in The Magic of Mom's Hugs grew directly out of moments I shared with my son. At one point, he was absolutely fascinated with animals. Our home was full of animal figurines, and we read many books about them together. Around that time, I used to tell him, while hugging and tickling him, that my hugs were magical.

One evening during our bedtime routine, he playfully asked what would happen if someone stole the magic from my hugs. Without thinking, I replied, "Then I would ask the animals to help me find it again."

That simple idea turned into a story we started imagining together, talking about which animals might help and what they might say. I still remember those early conversations and the laughter that came with them.


Two years later, I realized how special those moments had been, and how parents can sometimes lose their magic under the weight of work and responsibilities. I decided to write the story down so that those memories, and that little piece of magic, could live on in a book.

Q: Do you want to leave any message for your readers?

Through my books, I hope to help families slow down, connect, and treasure both the magic of quiet moments and the excitement of active ones, turning everyday life into lasting memories. Writing The Magic of Mom's Hugs also reminded me of something very personal. When life becomes busy and overwhelming, I remember that the real magic is in those small moments of connection.

That idea has become a kind of compass for me. Whenever I feel overwhelmed, I pause and remind myself to look for that magic again- in a hug, in a laugh, or simply in being present with the people I love.

If the book can help families reconnect with those moments and turn them into lasting memories, then I feel that the story has fulfilled its purpose.

Q: How and when did your journey start as a writer?


My writing journey started when my third grade teacher asked the class to write a short story, for some reason, he liked my story and told me that I should become a writer. I believed him.

Q: Tell us something more about your book series.

The Wars Between is a Young Adult fantasy novel with illustrations by Karolina Piotrowski. It is set in a world with two major island nations, one a traditional monarchy, the other a democracy. These two nations have been at war for thousands of years, until the arrival of the main characters of the story, Outis Everett, a little known poet from the monarchy of Asalandia, and Gwenia Xiachang, a rebellious vegan from the democratic nation of Kastanair. These two meet and change the course of history.

Q: How did you create the magical system in your books and characters?

I created a group of characters who at times feel lost in their social roles and seek change. Characters that have been raised to hate each other, through centuries of propaganda, but still find empathy and sympathy for their so-called enemies.

Q: Do you want to leave any message for your readers?

Just like in the Hobbit, even the smallest of people can make a difference, however, this book has a strong anti war message and suggests alternatives to invading and defending. I also want to draw attention to the art of poetry and created a scenario where poetry is relevant and has an impact.



My teaching career spans over 30 years, from opening Montessori schools in South Africa, to teaching in the oldest Montessori school in Naples, Italy, to Homeschooling children in San Antonio, Texas. I enjoy jewelry making in my spare time and shelling on vacation.

Q: How and when did your journey start as a writer?

While homeschooling I began to formulate ideas for Montessori Life Skills Story Books. I intentionally chose animals to demonstrate the practical life skills as animals are unbiased, non prejudiced and children all relate to animals.

Q: Tell us something more about your book series.

I created this series because not every child has access to a Montessori classroom — but every child deserves stories that respect their development. In a world that can feel overstimulating and hurried, I wanted to create books that feel like a prepared environment: calm, grounded, and quietly empowering.


Q: How did you create the magical system in your books and characters?

Each story centers on meaningful work — pouring, cleaning up, setting the table, baking, sharing, focusing, learning continents and planets — told through softly illustrated forest animal characters in authentic Montessori settings. Rather than directing behavior, the stories simply honor the child's natural desire for independence and contribution.

The growing series includes titles such as:

- Biscuit Bunny Learns to Say No
- Pickles Cat Learns to Clean Up
- Skip Puppy Learns to Pour
- Caramel Cat Learns to Set the Table
- Snow Cone Bunny Learns to Bake
- Fudge Bear Learns the Continents
- Macaroon Owl Learns the Planets
- Toffee Squirrel Learns to Share

Together, they form a cohesive collection designed to support children at home, in classrooms, and in library spaces where they can see themselves reflected in purposeful, meaningful activity.
